Bark River, MI— Over 17,000 fans packed the hillside at the Bark River International Off Road Raceway to witness the intense racing action. The Hord Racing Team entered the weekend tied for first place in the points championship. During Friday's practice session the Mazda powered #9 was looked flawless on the new and improved track. Friday night into Saturday morning there was a significant amount of rain. Due to the rain, their was no Saturday practice and racing

was delayed an hour while the track crew prepared for racing. By the time the Pro-Light race came the truck was in great condition. Starting in sixth place, Chad battled his way into fourth place when the green flew. Chad worked hard, trying different lines, but was unable to get anymore out of his truck and would have to settle for fourth place. Saturday evening during the post race inspection, the crew discovered that the engine was bad. Fortunately, the

Mazda power plant, protected by AMSOIL, held together throughout the race. After an engine change Chad and the crew were ready for another round of racing and Sunday's practice session went well. Chad started in fifth place on the second day of the BOSS Snowplow sponsored event. Off the start he charged his way to the front and was running in second place by the mandatory caution. Chad, Marty Hart and Jeff Kincaid battled hard for the second half of the race, but it was the Hord Racing, Kumho Tired truck that could withstand the demands of such a fast pace and hold out to win their third race of the season.
